
Donations to Medical Institutions and Other Partners Responding to COVID-19

Mitsui Fudosan Co., Ltd. wishes to express its sincere condolences to those who have lost family members, friends, or colleagues because of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and to extend its heartfelt sympathies to those suffering from the disease.

Tokyo, Japan, June 19, 2020—Mitsui Fudosan Co., Ltd., a leading global real estate company headquartered in Tokyo, recognizes that in response to the global crisis triggered by COVID-19, one of the highest priorities of ESG management is to prevent the spread of COVID-19 with a view to ending the pandemic as early as possible. In order to fulfill its corporate social responsibilities, Mitsui Fudosan has been proactively assisting with measures to protect people's lives and their health and has been making a concerted Group-wide effort to realize a sustainable society based on the VISION 2025 long-term vision.

Mitsui Fudosan has decided to donate a total of ¥0.8 billion to several medical institutions, including Mitsui Memorial Hospital*, as well as to universities, research facilities and other partners. The recipients have been making tireless efforts with respect to COVID-19, such as treatment, testing, and vaccine development activities, and the medical institutions have continued to offer general outpatient consultations during the outbreak. Together with this donation, Mitsui Fudosan will continue helping to ensure a stable healthcare system by distributing supplies such as personal protective clothing, face masks and ready-made meals from its disaster stockpiles

The Mitsui Fudosan Group has been conducting the following activities with respect to the spread of COVID-19:

- (1) Ensure the health and safety of all visitors, guests and property staff through the temporary closure of retail properties and hotels
- (2) Provide supplies (such as face masks, beverages, ready-made meals and supplies for distribution to medical professionals and residents) to local governments and other entities in close proximity to retail properties
- (3) Provide business support to restaurant businesses (by hosting the Drive Through Marche event by restaurant tenants at MITSUI OUTLET PARK HOKURIKU OYABE and other restaurants in the local area)
- (4) Supported the Nihonbashi Bento Support Project undertaken by Nihonbashi Muromachi Area Management, a general incorporated association
- (5) Provide accommodation plans featuring donations to the Japanese Red Cross Society at THE CELESTINE HOTELS and Mitsui Garden Hotels
- (6) Donated to a meal delivery program for medical professionals at Hudson Yards (United States)
- (7) Supported foreigner workers in the construction industry with supplies, and distributed vouchers to medical-related professionals (Singapore)
- (8) Donated to the construction of temporary medical facilities with beds for COVID-19 patients (The Philippines)
- (9) Supplied face masks to neighboring communities of LaLaport SHANGHAI JINQIAO (China)
